Privacy Notice for California Residents

This Privacy Notice for California Residents supplements the information contained in the current Doncasters Group Privacy Policy and applies solely to all employees, businesses, visitors, users, and others who reside in the State of California (“Consumers” or “You”).

The Doncasters Group has issued this Privacy Notice to comply with the current California Privacy Rights Act of 2020 (“CPRA”) and any terms defined in the CPRA shall have the same meaning when used in this Privacy Notice.

Information We Collect

The Doncasters Group via its wholly owned US subsidiaries, Doncasters, Inc., Southern Tool LLC, Certified Alloy Products Inc., Avistud LLC and Trucast LLC, collects information that identifies, relates to, describes, references, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular identifiable Consumer(s) (“Personal Information”).

We have collected the following categories of Personal Information from Consumers within the last twelve (12) months:

Category A: Identifiers

Examples: A real name, Internet Protocol address, email address, or other similar identifiers.

Category B: Personal information categories listed in the California Customer Records statute (Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.80(e)).

Examples: A name, signature, Social Security number, physical characteristics or description, address, telephone number, passport number, driver’s license or state identification card number, insurance policy number, education, employment, employment history, bank account number, credit card number, debit card number, or any other financial information, medical information, or health insurance information. Some personal information included in this category may overlap with other categories.

Category C: Protected classification characteristics under California or federal law.

Examples: Age (40 years or older), race, color, ancestry, national origin, citizenship, religion or creed, marital status, medical condition, physical or mental disability, sex (including gender, gender identity, gender expression, pregnancy or childbirth and related medical conditions), sexual orientation, veteran or military status, genetic information (including familial genetic information).

Category D: Commercial Information

Examples: Records of personal property, products or services purchased, obtained, or considered, or other purchasing or consuming history or tendencies

Category F: Internet or other electronic network activity information

Examples: Browsing history, search history, and information regarding a consumer's interaction with an Internet website, application or advertisement

Category J: Education information (Information that is not “publicly available personally identifiable information” as defined in the California Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (20 U.S.C. section 1232g, 34 C.F.R. Part 99))

Category K: Inferences drawn from any of the information identified in this subdivision to create a profile about a consumer reflecting the consumer’s preferences, characteristics, psychological trends, predispositions, behavior, attitudes, intelligence, abilities, and aptitudes

Consumer Personal Information does not include:

- Publicly available information from government records.
- De-identified or aggregated consumer information.
- Information excluded from the CPRA’s scope, such as but not limited to:
- Health or medical information covered by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) and the California Confidentiality of Medical Information Act (CMIA) or clinical trial data;
- Personal Information covered by certain sector-specific privacy laws, including the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FRCA), the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA) or California Financial Information Privacy Act (FIPA), and the Driver’s Privacy Protection Act of 1994.

We obtain the categories of Personal Information listed in Category A-K above from the following categories of sources:

- **Directly from You.** For example, from filling in your new hire form.
- **Indirectly from You.** For example, from our benefits providers or reviewing benefit plan design.

Use of Personal Information

We may use, or disclose the Personal Information we collect for one or more of the following legitimate business purposes:

- **To process your employment eligibility.** For example, conducting background checks and employment verifications.
- **To process your pay and benefits.** For example, using direct debit information to ensure you are paid appropriately and sending information to third party providers for benefit enrollment.
- **To include for Equal Employment Opportunities Commission (EEOC) purposes.** For example, providing your demographics as required on an annual basis for use including enforcement, self-assessment by employers, and research.

Sharing Personal Information

We may disclose and/or transfer your Personal Information to a third party for legitimate business purposes. When we disclose Personal Information for a business purpose, we enter into a formal contract that describes the purpose and requires the recipient to both keep that Personal Information confidential with appropriate security and safeguards and not use, process, transfer or sell the Personal Information under any circumstances except in order to perform its contractual obligations under the contract.

Disclosures of Personal Information for a Business Purpose

- In the preceding twelve (12) months, we have disclosed Personal Information for business purpose to all providers as listed above.

Sales of Personal Information

- In the preceding twelve (12) months, we have not under any circumstances sold any Personal Information to any third parties nor have any of our trusted third-party service providers (to the best of our knowledge) sold any Personal Information we have shared/disclosed with them.

Your Rights and Choices

The CPRA provides Consumers with specific rights regarding their Personal Information. This section describes your CPRA rights and explains how to exercise those rights.

Access to Specific Information and Data Portability Rights

You have the right to request that we disclose certain information to you about our collection and use of your Personal Information over the past twelve (12) months. Once we receive and confirm your Verifiable Consumer Request, we will disclose to you:

- The categories of Personal Information we collected about You.
- The categories of sources for the Personal Information we collected about You.
- Our business purpose for collecting the Personal Information.
- The categories of third parties with whom we share the Personal Information.
- The specific pieces of Personal Information we collected about You (also called a “Data Portability Request”).
- If we sold or disclosed Your Personal Information for a business purpose, two separate lists disclosing:
 - sales, identifying the Personal Information categories that each category of recipient purchased; and
 - disclosures for a business purpose, identifying the Personal Information categories that each category of recipient obtained.

Deletion Request Rights

You have the right to request that we delete any of your Personal Information that we collected from you and retained, subject to certain exceptions. Once we receive and confirm your verifiable consumer request, we will delete (and direct our third-party service providers to delete) your Personal Information from our records, unless an exception applies.

We may deny your deletion request if retaining the information is necessary for us or our third-party service provider(s) to:

- Complete the transaction for which we collected the Personal Information; providing goods or services that you requested; take actions reasonably anticipated within the context of our ongoing business relationship with you; or otherwise performing our contractual obligation with you.
- Detecting security incidents; protecting against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent or illegal activities, or prosecute those responsible for such activities.
- Debug products to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality.
- Exercising free speech; ensuring the right of another Consumer to exercise their free speech rights or exercising another's right provided for by law.
- Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act (Cal. Penal Code § 1546 et. seq.).
- Engaging in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical or statistical research in the public interest that adheres to all other applicable ethics and privacy laws, when the information's deletion may likely render impossible or seriously impair the research achievement, if you previously provided informed consent.
- Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with Consumer expectations based on your relationship with us.
- Comply with a legal obligation.
- Make other internal and lawful uses of that information that are compatible with the context in which You provided it.

Exercising Access, Data Portability and Deletion Rights

Only You, or a person registered with the California Secretary of State that you authorize to act on your behalf, may make a verifiable consumer request related to your Personal Information. You may also make a verifiable consumer request on behalf of your minor child.

You may only make a Verifiable Consumer Request for access or data portability twice within a 12-month period. The Verifiable Consumer Request must:

- Provide sufficient information that allows us to reasonably verify you are the person about whom we collected Personal Information or an authorized representative; and
- Describe your request with sufficient detail that allows us to properly understand, evaluate, and respond to it.

We cannot respond to Your request or provide You with Personal Information if we cannot verify your identity or authority to make the request and confirm the Personal Information relates to You. We will only use Personal Information provided in a Verifiable Consumer Request to verify the requestor's identity or authority to make the request.

Response Timing and Format

We endeavor to respond to a Verifiable Consumer Request within forty-five (45) days of its receipt. If we require more time (up to 90 days), we will inform you of the reason and extension period in writing. We will deliver our written response by mail or electronically, at your option.

Any disclosures we provide will only cover the 12-month period preceding the Verifiable Consumer Request's receipt. The response we provide will also explain the reasons we cannot comply with a request, if applicable. For data portability requests, we will select a format to provide your Personal Information that is readily useable and should allow you to transmit the information from one entity to another entity without hindrance, specifically by electronic mail communication.

We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your Verifiable Consumer Request unless it is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded. If we determine that the request warrants a fee, we will tell you why we made that decision and provide you with a cost estimate before completing your request.

Personal Information Sales Opt-Out and Opt-In Rights

If you are 16 years of age or older, you have the right to direct us to not sell your Personal Information at any time (the "right to opt-out"). We do not sell the Personal Information of

Consumers we actually know are less than 16 years of age, unless we receive affirmative authorization (the “right to opt-in”) from either the Consumer who is between 13 and 16 years of age, or the parent or guardian of a Consumer less than 13 years of age. Consumers who opt-in to Personal Information sales may opt-out of future sales at any time. To exercise the right to opt-out, You (or Your authorized representative) may submit a request to us by either:

Once you make an opt-out request, we will wait at least twelve (12) months before asking you to reauthorize Personal Information sales. However, you may change your mind and opt back in to Personal Information sales at any time. We will only use Personal Information provided in an opt-out request to review and comply with the request.

Non-Discrimination

We will not discriminate against You for exercising any of your CPRA rights. Unless permitted by the CPRA, we will not:

- Deny you goods or services.
- Charge you different prices or rates for goods or services, including through granting discounts or other benefits, or imposing penalties.
- Provide you a different level or quality of goods or services.
- Suggest that you may receive a different price or rate for goods or services or a different level or quality of goods or services.

However, we may offer you certain financial incentives permitted by the CPRA that can result in different prices, rates, or quality levels. Any CPRA-permitted financial incentive we offer will reasonably relate to your Personal Information’s value and contain written terms that describe the program’s material aspects. Participation in a financial incentive program requires your prior opt in consent, which you may revoke at any time.

California’s “Shine the Light” law (Civil Code Section § 1798.83) permits users of our website that are California residents to request certain information regarding our disclosure of Personal Information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes.
